



Financiamento nacional por tipo de entidade









- intervention on the whole **city region food system**
- **10 European cities**, of different size and geographical settings, across Europe
- development and implementation of urban food systems policies, related actions and innovation accelerators/living labs
- **public and private stakeholders** throughout the whole food system
- partner with **local authorities** with a view of creating political commitment

FNR-15-2020: Pilot circular bio-based economy cities: sustainable production of bio-based products from urban biowaste and wastewater

2018 EU Bioeconomy Strategy → ‘cities should become major circular bioeconomy hubs.’

- pilot group of **10 European cities** to draft, launch and implement the bio-based part of their **urban circular bioeconomy** strategies and to monitor and assess the results.
- This topic is not about reducing waste, but only covers its **valorisation** through the **production of bio-based products from urban biowaste and wastewater**

LC-SC3-SCC-1-2018-2019-2020: Smart Cities and Communities

- role of cities to rapidly reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adapting to climate change
- Integrated innovative solutions for **Positive Energy Blocks/Districts** will be developed and tested and performance-monitored in the Lighthouse Cities
- interaction and integration between the buildings, the users and the larger energy system
- Lighthouse Cities will closely collaborate with the Fellow Cities

LCA-CLA-11-2020: Innovative nature-based solutions for carbon neutral cities and improved air quality

- **Nature Based Solutions** in diverse structures and configurations (e.g. mix of vegetation and trees, species, shape, spatial distribution of public green space and vegetation coverage)
- **optimal solutions and appropriate typologies** fitting to different contexts in terms of different climatic, environmental and socio-economic conditions and different urban designs
- **Benefits and co-benefits** (including citizens' health and well-being)
- **Tools, models, design guidelines, standards and protocols** to integrate these solutions into **local decision making**, including in spatial planning

LC-CLA-13-2020: Climate Resilience of European coastal cities and settlements

- **coastal resilience plans** and **adaptation pathways** (i.e. protect, accommodate, or retreat options)
- state-of-the-art **predictions of sea-level changes** on time scales of years to decades to identify urban coastal areas at risk of flooding and erosion
- assessment of the **robustness and effectiveness** of protective structures measures and governance structures
- **resilience plans** for vulnerable urban areas implementing
- pilot studies comprising "**front-runner" cities** advanced in the elaboration and implementation of coastal adaptation and resilience plans mentoring "**follower" cities**

SC5-27-2020: Enhanced natural treatment solutions for water security and ecological quality in cities

- methodologies and guidance for the design and implementation of **urban enhanced natural treatment systems** and their integration into the urban water cycle, the urban landscape and the receiving waters
- **new business models** for their construction, operation and long-term management and maintenance and standards for the treatment processes and the different uses
- **pilots/demonstrations** for testing innovative approaches or the use of established solutions under new conditions and monitoring
- methodologies for **public/social engagement**
- **at least 3 cities** from different Member States or Associated Countries
- EU-China flagship initiative on Environment and Sustainable Urbanisation


